Purpose

- Create a high quality, rich, stimulating and enabling learning environment that is planned to ensure accelerated progress but also contains items that will capture pupils' attention and lead to independent exploration.
- Make effective use of assessment information on pupils' attainment and progress when teaching and in planning future learning. Ensuring that all learning is appropriately differentiated so that the learning is well pitched, and all pupils are challenged at their current level of understanding.
- Plan, prepare and deliver outstanding lessons to provide students in Years 3 to 6 with the opportunity to achieve their maximum potential in areas of ICT and Computing.
- To set high expectations for behaviour and take responsibility for managing it in the classroom, but also upholding this expectation with all children on all school sites. To continue maintain professional knowledge.
- To maintain high professional standards of communication with parents. This includes but is not limited to delivering parents' evenings, parent curriculum evenings, writing school reports and communicating professionally through email when needed.
- To participate and represent in the wider life of the school. This includes but is not limited to whole school staff meetings, carol concerts, school fairs and PTA events.
